6-7 weeks after conception

The baby's heart has been beating for three weeks / all vital organs are present / fingers, feet, toes are developed / arms, legs move / sex can be determined / brain waves can be detected.

"Within the sac was a tiny human male swimming extremely vigorously in the amniotic fluid. This tiny human was perfectly developed with long, tapering fingers, feet and toes...The baby was extremely alive and swam about the sac approximately one time per second."

8-9 weeks after conception

The baby feels touch and is responsive to pain / will grasp an object and make a fist / sucks thumb / swims freely with a natural swimmer's stroke / heartbeat can be heard on ultrasonic stethoscope.

"...a baby at two months gestation who can swim or play trampoline inside the uterus is also able to feel something. And particularly because the person is very tiny, you can use a hair and tickle his upper lip and at two months of age he's already able to remove his whole body to escape the stimulation."

19 weeks after conception
